Town Manager's Report January 16, 2018

Due to the impending winter storm tomorrow, there will be a parking ban in effect from 11PM this evening (Tuesday

1/16/18) until 7AM on Thursday, 1/18/18. Parking is prohibited on all public streets during a parking ban. Vehicles parked on streets during snow plowing operations hinder snow removal efforts, and put the vehicles in extra danger of being damaged or plowed in. Vehicles parked in violation of a parking ban may be ticketed or towed depending on the severity of the obstruction.

Freeport residents are allowed two (2) 5-gallon buckets of sand per storm. Sand is located adjacent to the silver recycling bullet on Hunter Road in front of the Public Works Facility.

For residents who park vehicles in driveways, please keep sidewalks clear so our sidewalk machines are not restricted in doing their job.

I would like to extend a special "thank you" to our Public Works and Buildings and Grounds Maintenance departments, who have had quite a bit of extra work over the past three weeks due to winter storms and snow removal operations. We have gotten many compliments from residents about the great job they did during the blizzard on Thursday 01/04/18. A special recognition goes out to the Buildings and Grounds Maintenance Department. If you look closely at the photo at

right, the spreader attached to their sidewalk tractor is sporting a custom salt deflector, designed to direct the sand and salt downward onto the pathway instead of spreading it where



it's not needed. But unlike other custom deflectors, this one was created from a few scrap used parking signs, saving the Town some money in the process!

Winter Safety Tips from Freeport Public Safety

Around the House:

- Clear roofs of excessive snow and ice buildup.
- Keep all chimneys and vents clear to prevent carbon monoxide from backing up into the building.
- Keep exits clear of snow so that occupants can leave safely in the event of a fire or emergency.
- Check on smoke detectors, including battery.
- Do not thaw pipes with an open flame.

On the Road:

- Slow Down: Driving too fast on wintry roads is the leading cause of crashes.
- Travel at a safe distance of at least 3 car lengths, leaving plenty of room to stop.
- Do not crowd slow moving maintenance and emergency vehicles.
- Do not use cruise control while driving in a storm.
- Do not overestimate the capabilities of your fourwheel drive vehicle.
- Clear all snow and ice from the vehicle prior to travel (Don't forget the roof!).
- Be aware of black ice on what appears to be bare pavement.
