

CHAPTER 40 OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC PASSAGE

ARTICLE I OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC PASSAGE ORDINANCE

Section 40-101

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the Obstructing Public Passage Ordinance of the Town of Freeport.

Section 40-102

It shall be unlawful for any person, either alone or in consort with others, to purposely or recklessly hinder or impede:

1. The free and uninterrupted passage of vehicles, traffic or pedestrians on, upon, across, over or to any public way, public sidewalk or other public place or building;
2. The free and uninterrupted use of, or access to, any property or business adjacent to, upon or facing or fronting on any public way, public sidewalk or other public place or building.

Section 40-103

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction therefor, be subject to a fine of up to \$100.00 for each violation, which fine shall enure to the Town of Freeport.

The provisions of this section were adopted as an Ordinance August 6, 1974.
