All of the following information is required and must be submitted for all commercial building permit applications.

- O Scaled plot plan with all lot lines and existing and proposed changes.
- O Floor plans end elevations of all existing and proposed construction.
- O Foundation plans with rebar specifications and required drainage.
- Cross sections of framing details (see cross sections sheet), including but not limited to, foundation, floor, wall, stair, ceiling, and roof sections per 2015 IBC.
- O Insulation R-factors of floors, walls, ceilings, and foundations per 2021 IECC.
- O Proposed Air Sealing and Insulation R-factors of conditioned spaces, per 2021 IECC.
- O Name of Certified Technician for Blower Door and Duct Testing, per 2021 IECC.
- O Window and door U-factors per 2015 IECC
- O Window and door schedule.
- Mechanical drawings for any specialized equipment such as furnaces, chimneys, gas equipment.
- O Complete electrical and plumbing layout.
- O Right, Title, or interest for proposed application.

Statement of Special Inspections

2015 International Building Code (IBC) adopted by the Town of Freeport has specific requirements for structural tests and special inspections. These tests and inspections are in addition to the inspections required by the building official. All tests and inspections shall be made by an approved agency.

The approved agency must be employed by the owner or design professional in charge acting as the owner's agent.

The design professional shall prepare a Statement of Special Inspections, for submittal by the permit applicant. The statement shall include the following:

- 1. The materials, systems, components and work required to have special inspections.
- 2. The type and extent of each inspection.
- 3. The type and extent of each test.
- 4. Identification as to whether it will be continuous or periodic inspections.

The special inspector shall provide written inspection reports to the design professional.

NOTE: Special inspections do not waive the requirement for inspections by the building official. The contractor shall schedule all Town required inspections with this office.

A final Statement of Special Inspections shall be provided to the building official. This statement must be submitted to the building official before final inspection.

Include the checklist below when preparing the Statement of Special Inspections. Remember to include all testing agencies, inspectors, and inspection schedules. Feel free to contact the building official with any questions or concerns.
