Coastal Waters Commission (the Commission) Meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm on May 20, 2020 via Zoom video conference.

Harbormaster Report

Charlie shared the water front is off to a slow start. The Lilly B is not running yet, and the mooring field is beginning to fill up. There is one aquaculture site proposed for a site off of Wolfe Neck.

A proposal was made to charge a \$50 fee for aquaculture applications. Mr. Stenzel moved to approve the motion and Mr. Frazer seconded the motion. There was no further discussion and all members of the Commission voted in favor of the fee.

Wharfing Out Permit

Mr. Becker presented the Cheney-Olson application for 33 Bartol Island Road. Review and discussion of the application revealed the application meets the criteria within the ordinance. Ms. Orlando moved to approve the application as presented, and Mr. Frazer seconded the motion. There was no further discussion and all members of the Commission voted in favor.

Mooring Placement Appeal

Negotiations related to LPA appeal of the denied mooring placement are ongoing. As such further discussing of the appeal will be tabled to the next meeting tentatively scheduled for July 17th. Motion to table discussion to the next meeting was made by Mr. Benway, and seconded by Ms. Orland. There was no further discussion and all members of the Commission voted in favor.

Old Business – Wharfing Out Permit

The wharfing out permit for of Caroline and Marcus lafrate of 77 Spar Cove Road was presented by Mr. Becker. This application was originally presented at the February 12, 2020 meeting with no items of concern noted. Review and discussion confirmed the application meets the criteria within the

ordinance. Ms. Orlando moved to approve the application as presented, and Mr. Benway seconded the motion. There was no further discussion and all members of the Commission voted in favor of the fee.
