- 1. Minutes of April 2019 meeting were approved
- 2. Director's Report
- Arlene is waiting to hear back from the Town concerning a proposal from CivicPlus to start building a new Library website. The site would use CivicPlus templates, similar to the Town's website.
- Arlene discussed a need for acoustic panels. The sound that carries from the DVD section and the children's wing can make it difficult to work at the circulation desk. We might want to add investigating the cost of panels to the Board's Summer homework. Karin asked if is was possible to close off part of the entrance to the DVD section, and Arlene said there might be fire code issues with doing that.
