Town Manager's Report March 19th, 2019

Staff Update- Planning Board

Donna Larson, Town Planner, is resigning her position with the Town to take a position in the private sector with a local planning and engineering consulting firm. Her last day with the Town will be on March 28th.

Donna has worked for the Town for 19 years, and has been closely involved in the majority of development projects that have taken place during that time. During her tenure as Town Planner, Donna also took on many projects outside of the traditional Town Planner's role, specifically focusing on energy efficiency and sustainability. Many of these projects have resulted in environmental and financial benefits to the Town. Examples are numerous heating and lighting efficiency upgrades at Town facilities, the installation of LED parking lot lights, and current projects such as LED streetlight conversions, and ongoing investigations into solar power, to name a few. Her work has had a great deal of influence on the way that the Town has developed during her time here, and personally, I'm thankful for the contributions that she has made to our community. I hope you will join me in wishing her continued success.

On March 1st, Sergeant John Perrino retired after thirty years of service with the Freeport Police Department. Prior to his time in Freeport, John served as an Officer with the Auburn Police Department. Please join me in wishing John the best in his retirement.
