Pete shared we should add 2 senior non-resident residential license. Motion made and approved unanimously. After further discussion the commission voted to not allocate the number and ask the town clerk to allow up to 2 senior non-resident recreational licenses and 18 senior resident recreational licenses per the state statute. Passed unanimously.
