

Brewer Lot Parking rules – Resident Overnight

Concerning the leased lot in South Freeport at the Harbor

Approved by the Freeport Town Council March 1, 2011

1. A limited number of these permits are available each day that the lot is open during the summer, for a fee of \$5.00 per day, available from the Public Safety Office, or from the Harbormaster when he is available.
2. No trailers are allowed in the parking spaces under this program.
3. Overnight resident parking permits allow a vehicle to park in the lot when the lot is normally closed—from 11 pm to 7 am—for a fee of \$5.00 per day. Permits may be purchased for no more than two consecutive nights at one time.
4. If a permit is available, it does not guarantee the availability of a parking space. If a space is not available, the purchaser may return to the Public Safety Office within two hours of obtaining the permit for a full refund.
5. The permit must be placed conspicuously on the vehicle dashboard, driver's side.
6. The parking vehicle information and license plate number must be provided to the Town. The permit is not transferable to another vehicle.
7. Up to four (4) spaces will be available under this program. However, the Harbormaster and Police Chief have the authority to reduce the number of spaces on a daily basis, based on their experience and knowledge of planned activities.

A sign at the entrance to the parking lot will be installed, as shown here:

- Parking Notice
- Parking is often not available in South Freeport during the summer. Drivers are encouraged to carpool, and use remote parking such as the Park-N-Ride lot on US Route 1 (1/2 mile north of South Freeport Road.)
- A limited number of resident overnight permits are issued for this lot for a fee of \$5.00 from the Freeport Public Safety Office, 4 Main Street; 865-4800.
