ITEM # 40-19 To consider action relative to the Fiscal year 2020 tax due dates and interest rates.

BE IT ORDERED: That one-half of the fiscal year 2020 committed taxes for real estate be payable on November 18, 2019 with interest at the rate of .66 per month or 8% per annum, to be charged from November 19, 2019 and that the second half of the fiscal year's 2020 committed taxes for real estate be payable on May 18, 2020 with interest at the rate of .74 per month or 9% per annum, to be charged from May 19, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED: That the fiscal year 2020 committed taxes for personal property be payable on November 18, 2019 with interest at the rate of .74 per month or 9% per annum, to be charged from November 19, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED: That an interest rate of 0% per month or 0% per annum be established for overpayment and/or pre-payment of taxes.
