- 3. Property updates
  - a. Soule Park
    - i. No updates
  - b. Florida Lake
    - i. Ben Shepard fixed a bridge, started dismantling another decayed bridge
  - c. Hidden Pond
    - i. On this year's Freeport Conservation Trust Passport Challenge
    - ii. Ben Shepard wants to use an extra piece of Plexiglas from the Quarry Woods kiosk to fix the Hidden Pond kiosk
