

SECTION II - PREREQUISITES

ADOPTION BY THE JURISDICTION REQUESTING APPROVAL

Requirement §201.6(c)(5):	[The local hazard mitigation plan shall include] documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of the jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan (e.g., City Council, County Commissioner, Tribal Council).
Requirement §201.6(c)(5):	For multi-jurisdictional plans, each jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan must document that it has been formally adopted.
