- >> 2) Review the Project Canopy recommendations and what TTF has worked on thus far, especially our identification of downtown sites in need of tree/plantings and preservation of existing ones: positive potential.
- >> 3) Emphasize- last task for applying for Tree City designation is an Ordinance, doing so gives us accesss to grant opportunities
- >> 4) Amplify the science-based benefits (environmental/human health, wellness, social equity/ economic) of green infrastructure
- >> 5) Talk about getting ahead of the downtown re-development certain to occur over the next several years especially parking lots and dense residential housing construction.
- >> 6)Underscore the interfacing with Complete Streets, Project Review Board and necessity for inserting, aligning tree-specific language across boards; and for Freeport leadership to advance/standardize green infrastructure especially tree canopy, as a foundational principle of our urban planning.
