WHEREAS the Covid pandemic poses a serious threat to the health and welfare of the residents of Freeport, and

WHEREAS the development of vaccines offers protection to Freeport residents from the disease; and,

WHEREAS providing Freeport residents the benefit provided by the vaccine requires the effective vaccination of its residents, and

Whereas The Town of Freeport has both trained personell and public space necessary to administer the vaccine to its residents as soon as it is available:

The Freeport Town Council urges the Governor of the State of Maine ,the Maine CDC ,and other relevant agencies of the State to make full use of the Town's resources to insure its residents are vaccinated as soon as the vaccine is available and that no time is lost in reliance on other means of vaccination unless the State is confident that using those means will result in the more rapid vaccination of the residents of our community
