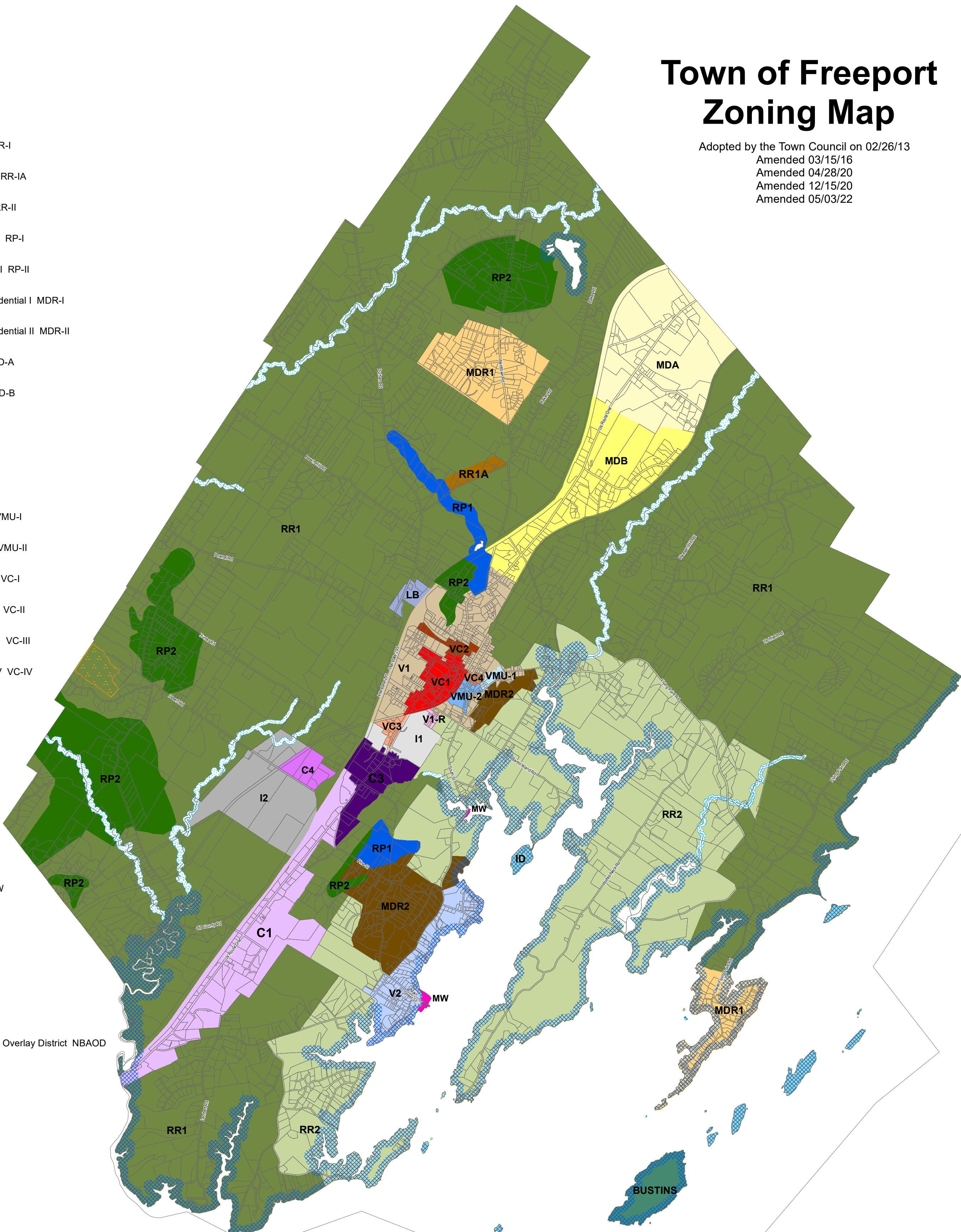


Town of Freeport Zoning Map
