Other Business:

- Town Clerk Mary Wescott pointed out the six peddler spots she had chosen in Town; Council wished to have the Grove School spot replaced by another; the Clerk would get back to the Council with a new spot or spots.
- 2. Town Manager Dale Olmstead reported on having the debris from the old Middle School picked up; he has requested two local contractors to give him a bid and wanted a concensus from the Council to accept the better bid of the two; Council gave their concensus; some councilors were concerned about the safety of the gym and more bidders were needed.
- 3. Councilor John Nelson hoped they would be able to get new recruits to fill some of the vacancies coming up on various boards; he hoped the new form would encourage people to state what boards they would be interested in serving.
- 4. Fire Chief Darrel Fournier gave a report on the January 27 fire at the old Middle School; the fire was discovered by Officer Mike Whitehouse; the Fire Department had some difficulty with loss of water pressure at one point and lost approximately 10 minutes waiting for water; some of his firefighters had to be evacuated from inside the burning building because of the roof collapsing; the following morning permission was obtained from the Town Manager to completely demolish the building; Mr. Fournier praised all who worked and wished that the Council might recongnize these people, some who took their days off to come in and help fight the fire plus help clean up some of the debris; Council will formulize some sort of resolution recognizing the efforts not only of the Freeport Fire Department, but, neighboring fire departments who also answered the fire call. Mr. Fournier reported this was a fast, moving fire.

Police Chief William Stone gave a police report and stressed that Fire Chief Fournier handled the situation by radio contact and did a fine job; one of the suspects was arraigned in Brunswick District Court, this morning, and has been charged with a greater Class A Crime; Mr. Stone praised Sergeant Whitehouse for staying with it and apprehending the culprits so readily.

5. Town Manager Olmstead attended a regional waste meeting in Windham and stated the talk of the managers was the fire in Freeport; they praised the Freeport firefighters and gave some suggestions as to fire equipment; Councilors were advised that Freeport does not have a Mutual Aid Agreement with Lisbon, however, Lisbon did respond to the fire call and very soon a signed Mutual Aid Agreement would be forthcoming.

Ron Seaman from the Water Company reported 600,000 gallons were used to put out the fire.
