- 3. Mr. Bonney received a letter from Ronald Holbrook requesting a zone change to allow for low income housing; this item will be discussed at the workshop scheduled right after this meeting.
- 4. John Nelson has expressed an interest in Freeport hosting an upcoming MMA meeting; Chairperson Bonney stated this is a future item/next week.
- 5. COG's General Assembly will be separated into two different meetings this year Thursday, May 28 and Tuesday, June 23; councilors are invited to attend.
- 6. Chairperson Bonney received correspondence from Gloria Morin expressing her concerns that Blue Onion has not complied with certain items; the Planning Board will be receiving copies of this letter.
