ITEM #122-88

Be It Ordered - That under and pursuant to Title 30, Section 5151 of the Maine Revised Statutes, as amended and supplemented, there be and hereby is authorized the issuance of Five-Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) principal amount of Tax Anticipation Notes of the Town of Freeport in anticipation of the receipt of taxes for the Municipal Fiscal Year which commences July 1, 1988 and ends June 30, 1989.

Be It Further Ordered - That said Notes shall be dated July 1, 1988, shall mature on June 30, 1989, shall be signed by the Chairman of the Town Council, shall bear interest at the rate of 5.3% per annum, shall be payable at Maine National Bank, and otherwise be in such form and bear such details as the signers may determine.

Be It Further Ordered - That said Notes are hereby sold and awarded to Maine National Bank.

Be It Further Ordered - That all things heretofore done and all action heretofore taken by the Town of Freeport, its Municipal Officers and Agents in the authorization of said Notes are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed, and the Treasurer and Chairman of the Town Council are each hereby authorized to take any and all action necessary or convenient to carry out the provisions of this voting, including delivering said Notes against payment therefore. ## Other Business:

- 1. Discussion on Wheelchair Lift for the B.H. Bartol Library: cost of the lift is approximately \$34,349; Michael Charek in a letter suggested that the project begin as soon as possible using the firm of Pelletier & Flanagan; Town Manager Olmstead stated this project could be bonded in the fall along with the school project; a public hearing will be set on this item for the June 21 meeting.
- 2. A letter of resignation was distributed to the Council from Chief Stone; there will be an executive session to discuss possible replacements for the Chief's position. Councilor Bonney praised Chief Stone for his ability to get along with the public as well as officials, for his honestness, cooperation, professionalism, his "personal touch".
