Other Business:

- 1. Discussion of process used for condemnation of structures: Fred Reeder, Codes Enforcement Officer, gave a very general explanation of what he looks for in condeming buildings and what the steps are leading up to the condemnation, specifically, he is looking for life threatening situations faulty electrical system, inadequate water supply, plumbing violations, to name a few.
- 2. Councilor Nelson mention that councilors get the evaluations to him right away.

- 3. Councilor Bonney reported that the Building Committee had met this past Monday; Stan Davis reported that the total cost of the blasting of all ledge came in \$200 under what we thought; we still have \$5,000.00 unemcumbered funds; we are going to be very close to original figures; site work is in process as well as exterior lighting; the Committee will be meeting again for final figures.
- 4. Chairman Hartnett mentioned the resignation of Morris Hancock from the Cable TV Committee.
