Nomination placed for Vice Chairman was Mr. Arthur Palmer. No other nominations being offered, it was Moved and Seconded that nominations cease and that the Chairman cast one ballot for Mr. Palmer as Vice Chairman. So Voted.

Appointment of Town Manager and Acting Secretary.

Moved and Seconded that Mr. Ness be appointed Town

Manager. (7 Yes) (0 No).

Moved and Seconded that Mrs. Briggs be appointed as Acting Secretary. (7 Yes) (0 No).

- Moved and Seconded To Table Item No. 4 until the next scheduled meeting. So Voted.
- Discussion of Recording Devices to be Used in Verbatim Recording of Council Proceedings.
