ITEM NO. 7 Be It Ordered - To borrow a sum or sums not to exceed \$700,000 in anticipation of real estate and personal property taxes, to be repaid before the end of the current municipal year from Canal National Bank and to authorize and instruct the Treasurer and the Council Chairman, and they are hereby authorized and instructed, to sign and execute on behalf of this Town a note or notes from time to time which in aggregate will not exceed the principal amount of \$700,000 and to do any and all acts necessary to effectuate the foregoing, and (7 Yes) (0 No) (Messrs Small & Bonney),

Be It Further Ordered - That the Canal National Bank be awarded the 1973 tax anticipation loan at a low bid of 2.05%. (7 Yes) (0 No) (Messrs Furtney & Palmer).

ITEM NO. 8 Appointment of Councilmen to the following Council Committees: Appointments Committee: Messrs. Bonney, Palmer and Fogg; Ordinance Committee: Messrs. Leighton, Bonney and Thompson; and Finance Committee: Messrs. Thompson, Palmer, Leighton, Bonney, Small, Furtney, and Fogg.

ITEM NO. 9

Be It Resolved

WHEREAS the Freeport Town Charter Article 10.07 deems that the 1972 Municipal Budget is adopted on a month-to-month basis until April 1, 1973, and;

WHEREAS the Freeport High School Band has been selected to represent the State of Maine in the Presidential Inaugural Parade on January 20, 1973 bringing great honor not only on the members of the band but to the community as a whole, and;

WHEREAS State Statutes specifically allow municipal appropriations to assist high school bands, therefore,

Be It Ordered - That the sum of \$300.00 be expended from the 1973 municipal budget to assist the Freeport High School Band in attending the Presidential Inaugural Parade, and

Be It Further Ordered - That the Treasurer of the Town of Freeport shall use monies from the following municipal accounts to satisfy this expenditure:

Memorial Day Account	\$100.00
Maine Publicity Bureau Account	200.00
Managers Conference Account	100.00
