- 1.2 Meither a municipal officer nor a member of the Zoning Board of Appeals may be a member of the Planning Board.
- 1.4 The Board shall annually elect a chairman and a vice chairman and a secretary from its own membership, and may create and fill such other offices as it may determine. Officers shall serve one-year terms and shall be eligible for re-election.
- 1.6 The Chairman shall call meetings of the Board as required and shall call at least one regular meeting of the Board each month. The Chairman shall also call meetings of the Board when requested to do so by a majority of the members or by the municipal officers. A quorum of the Board necessary to conduct an official Board meeting shall consist of at least four members. The Chairman or the Vice Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Board. The Chairman shall be the official spokesman for the Board.
- 2.10 The Planning Board shall submit a verbal status report of the Planning Board activities at every third formal Town Council Meeting.
