Be It Further Ordered - That the Highway and Fire Equipment Reserve Fund have \$6000 entered from the Fire Account under the Protection and Enforcement appropriation and \$5000 from the General Road Works Account under the Public Works appropriation in the 1974 Annual Budget.

Be It Further Ordered - That the Rescue Capital Reserve Fund have \$3000 entered from the Rescue account under the Protection and Enforcement Appropriation in the 1974 Annual Budget.

Moved and Seconded - That the amount to be appropriated for Leisure Time be reduced from \$46,675 to \$39,175 to be allocated as follows: \$30,175 for Library and \$9,000 for the Recreation Committee.
