Article II, Section 202(F)(1). A single lot of record which, at the effective date of adoption or amendment of this Ordinance, does not meet the minimum lot size, minimum road frontage, and/or minimum shore frontage of the district in which it is located, may be built upon without a variance provided that such lot is in separate ownership and not contiguous with any other lot in the same ownership and provided further that all other provisions of this Ordinance are met except that the minimum land area per dwelling unit or mobile home space standard requirement shall not apply to the construction or placement of a single dwelling unit or a single mobile home on such a lot of record the minimum set backs AND ANY APPLICABLE PETTOTMANCE STANDATES
TEGNITED BY THIS OFFINANCE SHALL BE WELL AL MEX!

Article VI, Section 601(G). (last paragraph) A variance is authorized only for minimum setbacks and maximum building/lot area ratio 10% area/10% powerage by structures/ and set backs minimum 10% size/ minimum road irontage/ maximum building/lot area ratio 10% area/10% minimum foad irontage/ maximum building beight/ minimum set back/ minimum land area per dwelling whit/ maximum building/lot area ratio and minimum shore 1700/10% A copy of all variances granted by the Board of Appeals to all land areas within 250 feet, horizontal distance, of the normal high water mark of all tidal waters shall be submitted to the State Planning Office.

ITEM #13-78

The Town of Freeport Hereby Ordains - That the following Amendments be made to the Freeport Zoning Ordinance:

Article II, Section 202(F)(1). A single lot of record which, at the effective date of adoption or amendment of this Ordinance, does not meet the minimum lot size of the district in which it is located, may be built upon without a variance provided that such lot shall be in separate ownership and not contiguous with any other lot in the same ownership, and that the minimum set backs and any applicable performance standards required by this Ordinance shall be met. All profit profitsions of this ordinance shall be met.

Article VI, Section 601(G). (last paragraph) A variance is authorized only for Xot area/ Yot coverage by structures/ and set backs minimum lot size, minimum road frontage, maximum building height, minimum set back, minimum land area per dwelling unit, maximum building/lot area ratio and minimum shore frontage. A copy of all variances granted by the Board of Appeals to all land areas within 250 feet, horizontal distance, of the normal high water mark of all tidal waters shall be submitted to the State Planning Office.
