

- 1. To assess, with the assistance of the Town Attorney, the Town's legal requirements and rights during installation and operation of a Cable Television Franchise and recommend to the Town Council any legal provisions which the Town should adopt for the purpose of instituting Cable T.V.
- With the explicit approval of proposals for services by the Town Council to negotiate with potential Cable T.V. Franchise operators to obtain a survey of service levels for Cable T.V.
- 3. To recommend to the Town Council the most desirable franchise contract for implementation in Freeport.
- 4. During the conduct of the Study Committee's operations, the Committee shall file written quarterly reports to the Town Manager for distribution to the Town Council.
