

"The Town of Freeport Hereby Ordains" the following: That a sum not to exceed \$255,000. is hereby appropriated for the purpose of constructing and equipping a sanitary landfill substantially in accordance with the plans, specifications and conditions as approved by the Maine Department of Environmental Protecti on application made on May 22, 1978 and for th purpose of closing the existing solid waste dumping area on the Pownal Road, and to meet said appropriation, the Chairman of the Town Council and the Town Treasurer are authorized to issue general obligation securities of the Town of Freeport in a total principal amount not to exceed \$255,000. and the discretion to fix the date, maturities, denomination, intere rate, place of payment, forms and other detail of said securities, including execution and delivery of said securities on behalf of the Town of Freeport is delegated to the Chairman of the Yown Council and the Town Treasurer.
