COUNCIL MEETING #7-80 APRIL 1, 1980

Town Manager Benway discussed a letter of resignation of a member of the Freeport Sewer District Board of Trustees.

Town Manager Benway stated that work had begun on the rebuilding of the Town Wharf - the project should be done by Memorial Day.

He also reported that:

State Aid Forms must be filed in order to complete the sidewalk project - Bridge Construction will begin work on April 14.

A walking patrolman item will be placed on the next Council agenda.

A letter is to be written to Fire Chief Dwight Libby thanking him for the Council's pleasure at the supper.

A senior patrolman in the Police Department is hospitalized thus increasing the problems in the Pepartment. Flowers in the Council's name will be sent.

Bradley Varney brought up 2 problems:

(a) a lack of enforcement of our clamming ordinance, and
(b) a lack of "cooperation" between the shellfish warden

and the Shellfish Commission.

Chairman Curtis requested a workshop is to be arranged with the Council and Shellfish Commission, also the Town Manager is to discuss the situation with Mr. Shorey. Councilor Lunt requests that Mr. Shorey be present at the workshop. Councilor Valliere requests that the charges be investigated and a

report be given to the Council. Council Chairman Curtis that these problems be on Tuesday night's

workshop agenda.

Edgar Leighton requested a meeting between the Townscape Committee and the Council sometime in the future.

Ken Carew wanted "matching commitments" explained regarding the L.L. Bean \$10,000 donation. Town Manager Benway read a letter from L.L. Bean explaining this. Also asked: Is the diagonal parking on the Westerly side of Main St. to remain? Answer: 'No, back to parallel parking".
