Mr. Lee Arris made a presentation of a money order to the Council which will be officially accepted and put on the next Council Agenda.

Town Manager Benway discussed a letter from Attorney Frinsko on the subject of Concealed Weapons Fermit. The Council endorsed submitting legislation to James Mitchell for introduction to the Legislature to provide for the iscuance of Concealed Weapons Permits by the State Commissioner of Public Safety. Council agreed to review an increase in fees and delegation of issuing permits to the Freeport Chief of Police.

Town Manager Benway discussed the Bragdon Road/Desert Pines Road. Decisions have to be made as to possible solutions for both roads. Mr. Benway asked the question: "Would the Council consider the risks involved of levying a special assessment used in lien processes but not having that irrevocable letter attached to it?" There will be future discussions/workshops on the issue.

Regarding the front-end loader: Some action has been taken to minimize a dangerous situation. The Town is renting a loader in the meantime - future work will be done on the Town's present loader in the amount of \$4,300 to bring it up to workable order.
