Mr. Frank Lee gave the Maine Vocational Region Ten Construction Report. The Cooperative Board of Maine Vocational Region 10 has requested a "concept approval" of the construction project to be considered by the State Board of Education on July 15, 1981. The Chairman of the Town Council was authorized to determine if the Freeport School Committee endorsed the project and then to notify the State Board of Education that the Town Council would not oppose placing a referendum question before the Voters of Freeport.

Town Manager Benway spoke regarding his "frustration" with the attempted try of hiring a Harbormaster/Clam Warden; most of the problems stemmed with the fact of the Clam Warden position and not the Harbormaster. At the present time, there is some coverage of the flats.

Councilor Lunt inquired regarding the status of the cable TV delay. The finalizing of negotiations is on the top priority list of the Council Chairman. Problems arose when there were discrepancies between the original proposed contract and the actual contract received from the Cable Company.

Council Chairman Swan will be meeting with Town Manager Benway and Councilor Willett to set up the rest of the Agendas for July and August.

Council Chairman Swan reported that a preliminary charge for a "task force" is in the works and will be presented to the Council in suitable fashion very soon.

There are vacancies on the Planning Board and Shellfish Commission stated by Council Chairman Swan.

Mr. Ken Carew brought out two particular problems that the Planning Board are encountering.
