Other Business:

Chairman Nelson mentioned a letter received from Bryan Sloat, President of the Freeport Fire Company, requesting Council's permission to allow the Freeport Fire Company to host the Annual Maine State Firefighters Convention in September of 1990; Council requested more information on this matter.

Chairman Nelson announced that on January 31, there will be a public meeting hosted by the Council to discuss the potential acquisition of the Soule Property which includes Hedgehog Mountain.

Chairman Nelson stated that the Winslow Park Committee met last evening; they have put together, with the help of Clay Carkin, a nature trail around the perimeter of Winslow Park with selected stops along the way - there is a brochure in the making; the Committee would like to hire Antoinette Jackman to do some pen and ink sketches - a total of 27 - which would be designating the stops at a cost of \$500 - this money has been set aside in the Winslow Park Operating Budget; councilors inquired about doing plaques along the way but the Committee felt this project would be too expensive and would become prey to vandalism; Council agreed to pay Ms. Jackman the \$500 for the sketches.

Councilor Bradley wanted an update on the relationship between mooring permits and federal violation laws; Coastal Waters stated the item came from the Shellfish Commission; none of the boardings would be done by town officials; Councilor Bradley specifically asked "Does the Town have the right to move a citizen's mooring if they are violating overboard discharge?" Coastal Waters will report back to Council; Councilor Bradley will investigate further.

Councilor Bradley inquired whether there will be a shellfish lottery this year? Town Manager Olmstead stated the State had not approved the language.
