Other Business:

1. Presentation of the Capital Improvements Program for Fiscal Year 1991 to Fiscal Year 1995.
2. Councilor Goddard suggested that towns be contacted again as a final push for the trip to Augusta; MMA made recommendations - one of them being that the Superintendent of Schools should be contacted along with councilors; Council announced there will be a bus leaving the Public Works Building on March 14 at 9:00 A.M. - donations would be accepted to help defray the cost of running the bus; one mailing has been sent to various Council Chairmen - a 2nd mailing will be sent out; name badges will be printed; county planning committees will be contacted; Chairman Stevens was invited to chair the tax group. Council hoped that members of the Freeport Tax Cap Group would ride the bus.
3. Councilor Campbell would like to see the School Budget presented the same way that the Municipal Budget is prepared.
4. Police Chief Schofield usually gets his 2 police cruisers from Bodwell Motors within the price range of \$12,800 - this year the price shot up to \$14,000 plus; Pape Chevrolet has cruisers equipped with police packages and fall in the price range of \$12,100; the Police Chief will check the vehicles when they go to bid.
